Hotel information

With its location right next to the bus station, right next to the metro station Florenc, the hotel is a superb starting point for your visit to Prague.

There are only few hotels in the center with comparable access to public transport or car. Metro (station Florenc metro line B + C) or tram stops are directly opposite and also a car park underneath the hotel!

Conference venue information:

Conference venue is situated in the **same block of buildings** as the Design hotel Elephant, thus it is not necessary to use a public transport to get there !! The conference is taking place in meeting room **Aplaus**.

Instruction for those who are arriving by car:

As soon as you will get on Prague circuit take a route into the **city centre** and get on **Wilsonova street (Magistral)** which enable you to pull off the road either straight on **Stárkova** street, which leads you to the hotel (more: arrival from airport) or on street **Ke Štvanici**. Follow this street and then turn right on the street **Na Poříčí** and then immediately to the left on street **Na Florenci** where you can find the hotel.

Arrival from the Václav Havel Airport to the hotel:

By car

Direction **Center**, go along **Evropská** street, at the roundabout take the second exit at **Československé armády street**, turn left onto **Jaselská** street, slightly to the right to **Pod Kaštany** street, continue to **Letenský Coronation tunnel**, then continue on **Štefánikův bridge**. After crossing the bridge turn left on **Lannova** Street and then left again at the first corner on street **Nové Mlýny**. At the end of the street turn right on street **Nábřeží Ludvíka Svobody** and after few minutes turn right on **Klimentská** street. After that turn right on **Stárkova** street which fluently changes into **Těšnov** and then continue straight forward where you will see **Design hotel Elephant** on the right side, sited on street **Na Florenci**.

By public transport

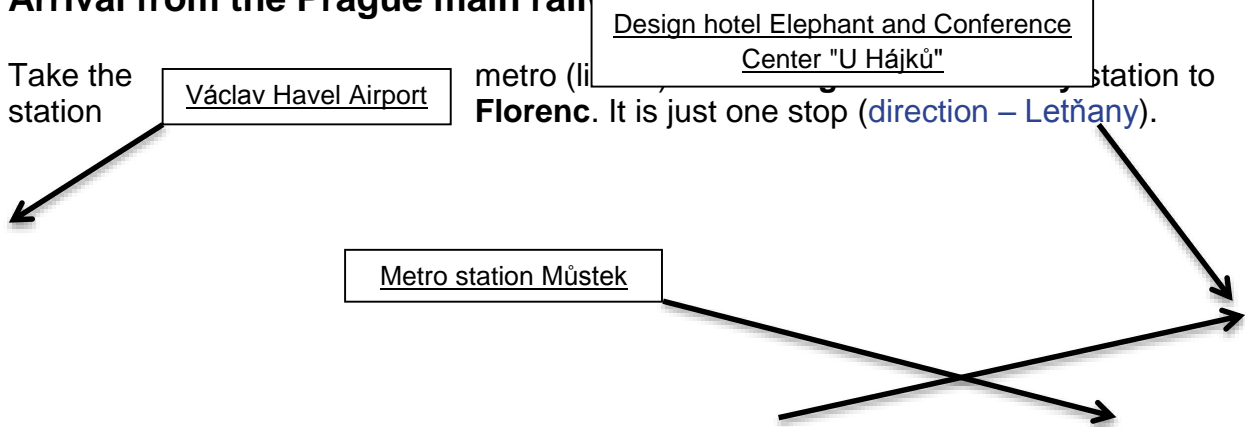
1st possibility: Take the bus **no. 119** from the airport to the final station **Dejvická** where you change for metro, line A and go from Dejvická Station to **Můstek** (direction - Depo Hostivař). There you change for metro, line B and go two stops to station **Florenc** (direction – Černý most).

2nd possibility: Take the bus **no. 119** from the airport to the final station **Dejvická** where you change for metro, line A and go from Dejvická Station to **Muzeum** (direction - Depo Hostivař). There you change for metro, line C and go two stops to station **Florenc** (direction – Letňany).

3rd possibility: Take a bus **no. 100** from the airport to the final station **Zličín** where you change for metro, line B and go from Zličín to **Florenc** (14 stops – Černý most direction).

Public transport and taxi:

In Prague you can use metro, tram, bus or funicular and choose from following tickets:

90 minutes = 32 CZK

30 minutes = 24 CZK

1 day = 110 CZK

3 days = 310 CZK

The public transport in Prague is much cheaper than taxi. The price of taxi is about 25 CZK for one kilometre and 40 CZK is the boarding rate. You can use for example **City taxi** (+420 257 257 257). For comfortable travelling in Prague you can see the website:
